1. Page 16, paragraph 3 and page 17, paragraph 2. There is no mention of the Time Critical Removal Action (TCRA), yet the draft Record of Decision stipulates that the "no action" alternative can only be considered after the TCRA. Please provide basis for this approach.
2. Table 7. For the constituent 4,4'-DDD, how can you have "ND" for range of positive detections when 1 out of three samples had positive detections? Please correct.
