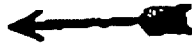

ATSDR ACTIVITY REPORT

1. The following information is taken verbatim from the Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry (ATSDR) fourth quarter FY-1995 activity report for Department of the Navy installations.

Marine Corps Base - Camp Lejeune, NC

The study of adverse pregnancy outcomes among women exposed to volatile organic compounds is ongoing. Birth records and housing records have been computerized. Work to match 19,000 birth and fetal death certificates each to one of 88,000 housing records continued in the fourth quarter. The matching process is projected to be completed during the first quarter, FY 1996. Half of the medical records for the feasibility study have been abstracted. The remaining abstractions should be completed during the first quarter, FY 1996.
