Dear Mr. Hubbell, Lt. Riechel,

Reference(a) passed on some correspondence between NEHC and the undersigned and asked three questions formally and one in a non-formal sense with the hope that one or both of you with your vast contacts re: MCB/CLNC and their IRR would clear the air about NEHC.

As noted before I have found correspondence between NEHC and LANTDIV SC CHPT. SACK's portrayal of NEHC as being un-involved in MCB/CLNC health ad safety / Hazards waste operations and emergency response ring rather hollow.

My first letter to CHPT. SACK of 18 September has obviously entered the dark void of naval activities associated with MCB/CLNC. I have no pre-conceived notions of NEHC's role re the remediation at CLNC, actually I am more interested in NEHC's role prior to NPL status, if that occurred.

Why CHPT. SACK responded in the manner he did seems rather strange given the innocuous nature of the injury. Perhaps a telephone call from HQMC or OJAG might unravel the mystery.
