SUBJ: Water Distribution Maps, MCB/CLWC 1968-1985

The website granted by MCB/CLWC includes maps delineating areas granted potable water from several water treatment plants.

The map of the Paradise Point Area, to include Berkeley Manor and Watkins Village, for the period 1968-1985 is colored to indicate Holcomb Boulevard WTP distribution.

The Holcomb Boulevard WTP was not constructed until 1972 and prior to that date Paradise Point and surrounds was serviced by the Hachot Point WTP.

In view of the increasing interest in the water distribution system and the contents of the various operable units (OUs) it is suggested that the Base Facilities Department re-issue maps, available to the public, that show the areas of potable water distribution prior to 1972 and after 1972 to reflect the construction and operation of the new Holcomb Boulevard WTP.

The period of the current ATSDR/NASC survey is 1968-1985.  
The Marine Corps needs to provide accurate information re: water distribution systems for that period -
