SUBJ: Chronology of Water Contamination at Marine Corps Base, Camp Lejeune

Dear General Mize,

Since 8 June with following letters of 2 July and 21 July
 I have been requesting the AC/S, Environmental Management
 Department to review, for accuracy, a statement made in
 the CLUE website "Chronology of Water Contamination - - -"
 for the period October 1980.

I believe the assertion made in the last sentence of that
 paragraph regarding the activities of a U.S. AEHA team on an
 inspection tour of MCBS water systems is incorrect and should
 be retracted. A LANTDIV NAVFACENGCOM letter of 12 February
 1982, referenced in prior letters, makes it clear that the C6, MCBS
 was informed in detail of the results of that TTHM inspection -

To date I have had no response to these three letters and
 the questions posed therein. This delay seems to be avoidable
 and is complicated by the fact that this assertion places the
 U.S. Army under unwarranted criticism.

A request for a senatorial inquiry will be made 10 August
 should no response be made by that date.
