were begun at eighteen (18) priority sites. The results of
these groundwater studies were documented in a report
provided to the Marine Corps in February 1985: as the Marine
Corps disagrees with the conclusions in this report, it will not
release a copy of it to any outside agency. Recently, however,
the Marine Corps did agree to provide DEM copies of the
technical data for review and interpretation."
