Reference (a) submitted to COMNAVFACENGCOM Environmental  
Division some recommendations concerning the use of  
newly developed techniques by the Agency for Toxic  
Substances and Disease Registry (ATSDR) to assist in  
epidemiologic investigations at Camp Lejeune.

There is a large at-risk population of military personnel  
and their dependents that were exposed to a range of  
contaminants in the water supply over a number of years  
and these now validated techniques seem appropriate to  
be utilized in further investigations at MCB, CLWC.

I would hope that EV has made contact with ATSDR to  
obtain the mass of materials relevant to these procedures  
and begun to assess where NAVFACENGCOM stands re: their  
future utilization at that NPL site.
