Persuant to our telephone conversation I contacted Oscar Howard and requested that he contact you in order to work out the particulars of the preliminary subsurface investigation, including the permissions to drill. As per our conversation and the constraints imposed by overhead utilities and paved parking areas, one of the auger rigs can perform the preliminary drilling.

The preliminary drilling should include borings around all the potential sources at both cleaning establishments and where possible, at locations between those establishments and the U.S. Marine Corps' production well, TT-26. The data collected during the preliminary drilling may very well isolate the source of the contamination, but it certainly will provide the basis for determining the necessity of further investigation by our section.
