

Update on Status of Subsurface Investigations at Camp Lejeune MCB, Onslow County.

Navy Assessment and Control of Installation Pollutants (NACIP)

The Marine Corps has let the contracts, 0.5 million dollars, for the subsurface investigations to document the contamination associated with the 22 priority sites identified in the NACIP report. The completion date for those investigations are not known.

The WiRO has concerns about some 16 additional sites on the MCB. The data presently available from the Marine Corps and the regional files is being reviewed and recommendations on the requirements for investigations at those 16 additional sites are being made. The submittal of those recommendations should be forthcoming in mid to late March.

Incident #3059, ABC One Hour Cleaners, Onslow County

Three of the water supply wells for the Tarawa Terrace water system have been contaminated by chlorinated solvents, principally perchlorethylene. A field investigation showed that the above mentioned establishment was the source. A NOV was issued by the WiRO to the owner of the establishment, Mr. Milton Melts, outlining the requirements for determination of the extent of the contamination and for a proposal for remedial action.

Due to a problem of completeness of the NOV document and the health of the owner, the WiRO has granted an extension of the due dates in the NOV. Essentially the clock was restarted at the first of this month.
