1. We need to collect July's samples, however, I don't think we need to collect all 8 systems anymore. I suggest we discontinue sampling Montford Point, Holcomb Blvd, and Courthouse Bay. I feel, due to its high average, that we need to continue monthly sampling at ~~the~~ New River. Our previous CG committed us to continue monthly sampling at the Rifle Range. Do to the extra samples we have to take in the Tarawa Terrace and Hadnot Point systems, despite their low averages, that they should be continued monthly for the time being. As for Onslow Beach, I would suggest that we continue monthly sampling for at least this month because it better than half way to the limit.
