Dear Mr. Adkins:

Marine Corps Base, Camp Lejeune will be conducting Remedial Investigation (RI) field efforts at the Hadnot Point Industrial Area (HPIA) from early November until late December. Eight groundwater monitoring wells will be installed and soil borings will be taken. The drilling rigs/augers will require decontamination (i.e., steam cleaning). We propose to decontaminate this equipment on a vehicle washrack in the HPIA equipped with an oil-water separator. Effluent from this oil-water discharges to the HPIA sewer system.

Decontamination of heavy equipment will occur in short periods sporadically during the RI process. Based on this site's past history, volatile organic compounds are the only suspected contaminants where drilling is to occur.

This approach was discussed with Ed Beck of your division. He concurred with this approach and recommended we document our intent in writing.
