## MEMORANDUM FOR CODE 1822

Subj: Community Relations Plan, MCB Camp Lejeune, N.C.

1. Overall the plan is excellent, I have some fairly minor comments:

a. The community interviews seem to be very representative and asked the right questions. However, there doesn't appear to be any follow up interviews with the additional people suggested for further interviews by the original interviewees.

b. Section 3.3.3. (page 21) mentions on-base Information Repositories having been established, but does not mention where they are.

2. One general comment after attending the TRC meeting July 25th. The citizen representatives on the TRC--Mr. Ray Humphries and Mr. John Mader--while qualified to judge the technical aspects of the IR Program, appear to be members of the "good old boy" network from Camp Lejeune. This could affect the public's acceptance of the decisions reached by the committee.
