The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Region IV has reviewed the above referenced decision document and concurs with the selected remedy for remedial action at Sites 6, 9, and 82 as supported by the previously completed Remedial Investigation, Feasibility Study and Baseline Risk Assessment Reports.

The selected remedy is a combination of "Intensive Groundwater Extraction and Treatment" and "On-Site Treatment/Off-Site Disposal of Soils". This remedial action is protective of human health and the environment, complies with Federal and State requirements that are legally applicable or relevant and appropriate to the remedial action and is cost effective.

It is understood that the selected remedy for Sites 6, 9, and 82, is the final remedial action to address all media potentially affected by past disposal practices at these sites.
