The North Carolina Hazardous Waste Section has reviewed the Final Brinson Creek Administrative Order on Consent Site Characterization Report, (Contract Task Order 0375), prepared by Baker Environmental, Inc. dated October 1, 1998. The prepared Site Characterization Report addresses Camp LeJeune's compliance with 40 CFR 262.11, as adopted by reference in 15 NCAC 13A .0107, issued in the signed Administrative Order on Consent docket number 98-052.

The results of the analysis provided by Quanterra Environmental Services, Inc. indicate the subsurface material at this site is not hazardous as defined by 40 CFR 261.20 and 261.24. At this time the United States Marine Corp Camp LeJeune is in compliance with Administrative Order on Consent docket # 98-052.
